Senior Lifeguard (Part Time Seasonal)

(up to \$15.17 per hour)

The Position

Under the general supervision of the Aquatics Director, this position supervises the staff and recreational activities at the City swimming pool; performs the full range of lifeguard and instructional duties, including provision for the safety of persons using the swimming pool and related areas; provides aid for persons in danger; and performs related work as required.

The Department

The primary role of the Recreation and Community Services Department is to provide the community with a diverse variety of recreational, aquatic, sports, youth camp and related programs and excursions. The Department is instrumental in conducting citywide special events, activities and services for the mature adult population, along with local transportation services. The Department also manages and operates the City's public community centers, aquatic facility, rental facilities and public parks.

The City

The City of Lynwood is a general law city pursuant to California Law and operates under the council-manager form of government. Five City Council members are elected at large to four-year, staggered terms. The Mayor and the Mayor Pro Tem are selected by their peers for a one-year term. The Council has adopted an exciting agenda for change that will result in an improved quality of life and increased community pride, laying the foundation for a vibrant and healthy future. Many members on the city's management team have been recruited within the past year and were selected not only for their impressive technical expertise, but also for their contagious energy, results oriented style and sincere desire to realize significant change for the betterment of the community.

Qualifications

Senior Lifeguards must be knowledgeable regarding principles and practices of swimming pool operation and routine maintenance; principles and techniques of lifesaving methods and the application of first aid; policies, rules and regulations governing the conduct and safety of persons using pools; and lifesaving equipment and its use. In addition, they must have the ability to supervise swimming pool operations and activities; supervise and train lifeguard personnel; supervise the conduct and safety of pool patrons and maintain order in a tactful manner; effectively use a variety of safety equipment; instruct in techniques of swimming and lifesaving; prepare clear and concise reports and read and write at the level required for successful job performance.

Requirements

One year prior experience as a lifeguard, and possession of Lifeguard and Lifeguard Instructor Certification, CPR for the Professional Rescuer and First Aid certificates.

Compensation and Benefits

The salary for the position will be up to \$15.17 per hour.
