Water Service Worker II

(Salary up to \$43,779 annually)

The Position

The Water Service Worker II is the second working level classification in the Water Service Worker series. Under general direction of a lead worker or supervisor, this position installs, maintains, and repairs water services, valves, mains, hydrants and meters; operates power-driven equipment used in water service work, performs a variety of maintenance trades work, and performs related duties as required.

The Department

The primary role of the Public Works Department is to plan, design and administer public works projects. The department provides engineering advice to the City Council, City Manager and various departments. The department is also responsible for repairs and maintenance of the city's water and sewer systems, streets, street lighting, parks and facilities.

The City

The City of Lynwood is a general law city pursuant to California Law and operates under a council-manager form of government. Five City Council members are elected at large to four-year, staggered terms. The Mayor and the Mayor Pro Tem are selected by their peers for a one-year term. The Council has adopted an exciting agenda for change that will result in an improved quality of life and increased community pride, laying the foundation for a vibrant and healthy future.

Qualifications

Knowledge of general water distribution facilities, including mains, meters, hydrants and valves; basic pipe laying, fitting, and concrete work; basic tools and equipment used in the installation, maintenance and repair of water mains, services, meters, hydrants and valves, and safety precautions and procedures used in water service work. Ability to repair, install and maintain water mains, services, hydrants, meters and valves; operate power-driven equipment used in water service work; repair, install and remove water meters; read water meters and make turn on and turn offs; interpret plans, drawings and specifications; and read and write at the level required for successful job performance.

Requirements

Two (2) years of experience in the installation, repair and maintenance of water services, mains, meters, valves and related equipment. Possession of a valid California Driver's License. Must obtain a Grade 1 Water Distribution Operator Certificate issued by the State Health Department within one year of hire date.

Compensation and Benefits

The salary for the position will be up to \$43,779 annually. The City offers a generous benefit package, which includes:

- **Retirement-** CalPERS 3% @ 60 retirement program
- **Medical Insurance-** Offered through the CalPERS Health Program
- **Dental and Vision Insurance**
- **Retiree Health Insurance-** Paid medical, dental and vision upon service retirement with CalPERS
- **Life Insurance-** Life and AD&D insurance
- **Deferred Compensation-** The City offers the CalPERS 457 plan.
- **Vacation-** Incurred at two weeks each year with increases based on years of service.
- **Sick Leave-** 96 hours annually.
- **Other Leave-** 10 paid holidays and 5 days floating holiday leave.
- **4-10 Work Schedule.**
- **Additional Benefits-** may include longevity pay, education incentives, an Employee Assistance Program, an opportunity for citywide training and a flexible schedule.
