**Lifeguard (Part Time Seasonal)**  
*(up to \$12.48 per hour)*

### *The Position*

Under the supervision of the Senior Lifeguard or Aquatics Director, this position provides for the safety of persons using the swimming pool and related areas; provides aid for persons in danger; and performs related work as required.

### *The Department*

The primary role of the Recreation and Community Services Department is to provide the community with a diverse variety of recreational, aquatic, sports, youth camp and related programs and excursions. The Department is instrumental in conducting citywide special events, activities and services for the mature adult population, along with local transportation services. The Department also manages and operates the City's public community centers, aquatic facility, rental facilities and public parks.

### *The City*

The City of Lynwood is a general law city pursuant to California Law and operates under the council-manager form of government. Five City Council members are elected at large to four-year, staggered terms. The Mayor and the Mayor Pro Tem are selected by their peers for a one-year term. The Council has adopted an exciting agenda for change that will result in an improved quality of life and increased community pride, laying the foundation for a vibrant and healthy future. Many members on the city's management team have been recruited within the past year and were selected not only for their impressive technical expertise, but also for their contagious energy, results oriented style and sincere desire to realize significant change for the betterment of the community.

## *Qualifications*

Lifeguards must be knowledgeable regarding lifesaving methods and the application of first aid; policies, rules and regulations governing the conduct and safety of persons using pools; and methods and practices of pool cleaning and maintenance. In addition, they must have the ability to rescue drowning swimmers and administer artificial respiration and first aid; supervise the conduct of pool patrons and maintain order in a tactful manner; use life lines, rings and other safety equipment; perform routine cleaning and maintenance of pool area; follow written and oral directions; and read and write at the level required for successful job performance.

## *Requirements*

Possession of Lifeguard Certification, CPR for the Professional Rescuer and First Aid certificates are required. Prior experience as a lifeguard is highly desirable.

## *Compensation and Benefits*

The salary for this position will be up to \$12.48 per hour.
